1. The judge's decision is final in all events.
2. Disputes are to be lodged within 30 minutes of the competition of any event and must be in writing accompanied by a \$50 fee.
3. All competitors must wear an approved helmet and be suitably attired in Pony Club uniform.
4. All riders must provide a helper for the event.

CONDITIONS:

Two Horse Rule: A competitor may ride two horses in the same or different heights. Each horse is eligible to be placed in each class and for Overall awards.

Combined Groups: Where insufficient entries are received in a particular class, it will be run as per rules for Combined Groups in rule book.
